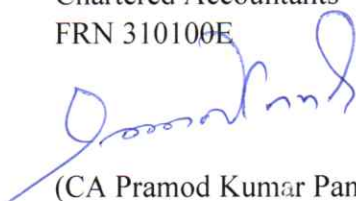

The assets are reflected on historical cost concept after depreciation where as movable assets are disclosed on book values.

**C. INCOME & EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT**

Income arises out of Grants-in-Aid and donation amount received during the year and expenses are attributable mainly towards the objective for which Grants received and other objectives of the society and other incidental expenses attributable to the day to day running of the Society which is recognised on accrual basis.
